Lions of Georgia, we would like to invite you to come see the new and improved Recycling Center at the Lighthouse. We have added cutting edge equipment and updated procedures to streamline the collection process.

If you are not able to volunteer, you can still help by collecting and donating items to the Lighthouse. Below are the new guidelines for collecting and separating your donations.

#### The Recycling Center ONLY accepts the following items:

Clear Eyeglasses      Sunglasses      Hearing Aids      Cell Phones

#### We do **NOT** accept

Batteries (of any kind)      Eyeglass Cases      Loose Lenses (as of Jan 2018)

#### Collect your sites as often as needed, following these instructions for sorting and delivery:

Please follow the guidelines below when preparing a donation. Sort your items into the following categories and put them in separate boxes labeled to indicate their contents, i.e. "Good clear eyeglasses"

#### **Clear Eyeglasses**

Remove all glasses from cases and bags; put all good glasses (with lenses, arms, and nose pieces in a box. Mark on the top of the box, indicating what it contains, i.e.; "good clear eyeglasses"

If glasses are broken- All clear eyeglasses that are broken, missing arms, lenses, or nose piece missing on the frames. Put into a box marked "ReSpecs".

#### **Sunglasses**

Remove all sunglasses from cases and bags, separate prescription sunglasses from regular sunglasses. Put all the good non-prescription sun glasses into one box. Mark the top of the box with correct contents, i.e. "Non-prescription sunglasses". Put all broken and prescription sunglasses into one box and mark the box on the top "ReSpecs".

#### **Hearing Aids and Cell Phones**

Take hearing aids and cell phones out of packaging cases, holders etc. Put all in one box. Mark box, "cell phones and/or hearing aids"

We DO NOT collect any chargers, wiring, cases or cordless phones. Clubs can collect and take to the co-op or the Goodwill.
