

The following policies are to ensure the safety of all patients and staff. Clinic staff reserves the right to deny entry if necessary.

Before entering clinic:

- 1. You must have an appointment for entry. Please press the buzzer on the intercom to inform clinic manager of your arrival.
- 2. After you inform clinic manager of arrival, you will be subjected to a temperature check and will be asked general health questions before entry.
 NOTE: If you have been sick within a week of your scheduled appointment or if you are showing any symptoms, your appointment will be rescheduled.
- 3. You may experience a wait prior to entry, depending on the number of patients inside. Please be patient, we will service you as soon as we can.
- 4. No family or friends will be allowed inside with you, unless medically necessary for mobility (only one person), or for translation purposes (must be 18+)



Upon arrival:

- 1. Masks are needed for entry! No masks, no service, NO EXCEPTION!
- 2. There will be a handwashing station inside where you will be directed to use upon entry. Hand sanitizer will also be available for use.
- 3. Please continue to use physical distancing measures (social distancing) by remaining at least **6 feet away** from others while you are inside during your appointment.
- 4. Please leave all extra items (coats/jackets, bookbags, purses, etc.) in your vehicle or at home. Only bring the items you need for your appointment.
