- Collect for the Recycling Center! We accept the following items:
 - Clear eyeglasses
 - Sunglasses
 - Hearing Aids
 - Cell Phones

Note that we cannot accept eyeglass cases, cordless phones, or phone chargers.

Collection Guidelines

Sort your items into the following categories and put them in separate, labeled boxes.

- **Clear Eyeglasses**
Remove glasses from any cases or bags; put all good glasses (with lenses, arms, and nose pieces intact) in a box labeled "good clear eyeglasses".
- **Sunglasses**
Remove sunglasses from any cases or bags, separating prescription sunglasses from regular sunglasses. Put all the good **non-prescription** sunglasses into one box or bag labeled "Non-prescription sunglasses".
- **Hearing Aids and Cell Phones**
Take hearing aids and cell phones out of packaging cases, holders etc. Put in a separate box or bag labeled "Hearing Aids and Cell Phones"
*Note that we **cannot** accept any chargers, wiring, cases or cordless phones.*
- **Loose Lenses**
Place all loose lenses together in a single box or bag labeled "Loose Lenses."
- **Broken glasses and prescription sunglasses**
Place any eyeglasses that are broken, missing arms, lenses, or nose pieces on the frames, and any **prescription** sunglasses into a separate bag or box labeled "ReSpecs".
