**The Frame Kit Program** is designed to provide high-quality, low-cost eyeglasses to patients referred by organizations/Lions Clubs looking to aid those needing assistance with vision care in their local community. It is an opportunity to provide a much-needed resource to those who would otherwise be unable to obtain eyeglasses while helping improve their quality of life.

### Conditions for participation in the Frame Kit program:

- A. The healthcare provider or Lions contact agrees to verify that clients meet the following requirements:
  - Household income is less than or equal to 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines
  - Georgia resident
  - Uninsured or underinsured for vision care
- B. The healthcare provider/Lions contact will need to have access to an optometrist or ophthalmologist who can provide eye exams as well as an optician to assist them with fitting and measurements for any patients referred.
- C. The healthcare provider/Lions contact will keep track of who they refer to the Georgia Lions Lighthouse Foundation, Inc. (GLLF) and agree to be billed for the costs of eyeglass fabrication. It is at the discretion of the eye doctor if they require payment for the patients exams.

Once the healthcare provider/Lions contact is able and willing to meet these conditions, they should contact Jennifer Martin at [framekit@lionslighthouse.org](mailto:framekit@lionslighthouse.org) or her direct line 770-738-4672. We will send your organization/club two Frame Kits (one for women and one for men) each containing 15 different frames for patient selection. The cost for the two kits is \$110. A children's frame kit with 15 frames is also available (\$55 kit cost). These frames should be stationed at the provider's location so that the patient can choose their frame on the same day as their initial visit.

In addition, we will also send the frame kit order forms for the eye clinic to complete once the patient has had their exam and has been fitted for an appropriate frame.
